

University of Oxford, New Mathematical Institute

Delivery of the University of Oxford's largest capital project for 100 years. Richard led the delivery of the 20,000m² new facility designed by Rafael Vinoly Architects resulting in a project that was handed over below budget and received a national gold CSCS Award. The project was awarded a BREEAM Excellent Award.

Centre for Life and Mind Sciences, University of Oxford

Richard was appointed in early 2018 to support the University and manage the Asbestos Removal and Demolition of a 30,000m² building in the heart of the science area. Richard has been re-appointed as part of the project delivery team seeking to implement a Centre for Life and Mind Sciences which sees the Departments of Experimental Psychology, Zoology and Plant Sciences come together in one new £200m building in the heart of the city centre. The building will feature offices and laboratories and is set to break ground given its objective of designing to Passivhaus Standards.

Manor Prep School, Sports Hall and Masterplan, Abingdon

Richard has been supporting the Manor Prep School to implement a significant planning consent and masterplan. Richard led the project team to obtain planning consent and deliver a new sports hall in the heart of the School's grounds and enable the site to develop subsequent phases including a new swimming pool.
