Duke's Wharf, Norwich

Part-conversion and part-development of the former headquarters of the Eastern Electricity Board offices. An opportunity was identified to use the then recently introduced Office to Residential Permitted Development Rights to establish the principle of residential development on the site, contrary to the site's allocation for office-led development. In addition, consent was secured for three new residential blocks in the centre of the site, resulting in a high-density development of 154 residential units.
