North Walsham West

Plots 1-21, Cambridge Science Park

Plots 1-21 is the most recent stage of the redevelopment of almost a quarter of the Cambridge Science Park and will be the new flagship face of the science park. The scheme provides two new technology centres delivering over 200,000 sqft of office floor space. The Urban Design Studio has provided landscape architectural services from RIBA Stage 1 through to handover.

Monarch's Park, Stamford
