BIDWELLS' GRADUATE SCHEME RECRUITMENT PROCESS

Our deadline for applications is in November. You can apply via our website **bidwells.co.uk/graduates** where you can find out specific dates and submit your CV. You will also be asked to answer a few questions.

- Once the deadline has passed, your application will be personally reviewed by a member of the Bidwells' resourcing team who will shortlist based on the quality of your CV, your qualifications, your work experience and your responses to the questions
- Those who are successful will be invited to take part in a video interview which can be completed in your own time. You will be asked three questions relating to your motivations, commercial acumen and behaviours
- The resourcing team and line managers will work together to decide on a shortlist of candidates who we feel give the strongest responses, who will then be invited to an assessment day. The assessment days will take place in January
